2nd grade- Field trip to a local nursing home to sing Christmas songs and deliver Christmas ornaments

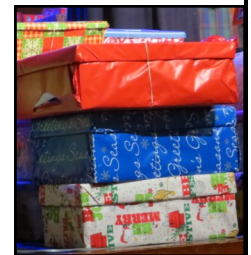
3rd grade – Color for the Cure; to raise money and awareness for Diabetes research
