Mrs. Jenny's 2-day, 3-day and 5-day Classes (8:30-12:00 P.M.)

Mrs. Jenny's Daily Schedule

- 8:15 - 8:30 - Arrival - Free Choice Centers/Computer
- 8:30 - 9:00 - Meeting Circle/ Group Activity
- 9:00 - 9:30 - Letter People /TouchMath
- 9:30 - 10:15 - Bathroom/Playground/Snack Time
- 10:15 - 11:00 - Centers (10 min. each)
- 11:00-11:30 – Cooking/Social Studies
- 11:30 – 12:00 - Bible Time / Prayer Journal

All students also have scheduled Spanish, Gym, Music, Computer Lab and Library once a week

We start off our day with open free-choice centers. The children can choose where to play after they put their snack and backpack away, and then give the assistant their folder. Then we have circle time. During this time, I choose the helpers, and we do our calendar, pledge and weather. Then we have a group activity focusing on the theme for the week.

After our activity, we meet our new Letter Person friend. We will spend some time getting to know things about our Letter Person, and sing their special song. We also use this time to learn our new number or review in TouchMath. After this time, we use the rest rooms, then line up to go to the playground. On the playground, they do play with many things such as chalk, bubbles, balls, sponges, and bowling pins.

When we get back from the playground, the children come in the classroom, get their snack and line up to go out to the pavilion. When we come in from snack, we have structured center time. There are 4 different color groups. Each color has the names and pictures of the children in the group on them. The children follow their color around the room as it moves every 10 minutes. Every child gets a chance to be at each of our 4 centers.

After centers are finished, we have Cooking or Social Studies. We cook every week based on the letter theme, and every 2 weeks we learn about a new country. The last part of our day is our Bible Story time. This is the most important time of the day, where they can learn more about God's Word and about how much God loves them! We have a prayer Journal that we keep in class to write all of the prayers both praises and requests every day. By having a prayer journal, the children see God answering their prayers. We review our Bible Verse, sing a couple songs, and line up for dismissal.

Most Commonly Asked Questions

Is the schedule the same every day?

Except for Wednesday, which is our Chapel day, the schedule is the same.

What is the difference between the 2-day and 3-day Program?

The 3-day curriculum follows the same syllabus as the 2-day program. Due to the extra day, additional varied activities are included to emphasize and reinforce curriculum skills. These students also attend Chapel on Wednesday mornings.

What about the 5-day Program? How does it differ from the 3-day and 2-day?

The 5-day Program is a combination of the 2 and 3-day program. Additional activities are added, and social skills are more developed due to additional time in the classroom.

How does Drop-off and Pick-up work?

The students are dropped off in the morning at the classroom. Parents must park and drop them off. At 11:30 when our class is over, the students wait outside and I walk them to their cars. If your child stays for Preschool Enrichment they are picked up at 3:15 in the room.

Who provides the snack at snack time?

The parents send the snack every day.

I'm concerned my son/daughter won't use the bathroom at school, how do you remind them?

We let the children know that they can go to the bathroom anytime, and ask them frequently if they need to.
